The British National Chapter of the International Association of Hydrogeologists, and the Hydrogeology Group of the Geological Society of London jointly arrange the annual 'Ineson Distinguished Lecture' series. These lectures are held in memory of Dr Jack Ineson who, as Chief Hydrogeologist of the British Geological Survey and latterly of the Water Resources Board, introduced quantitative hydrogeological science to Britain during the 1950s and 1960s.
